

High Level Changes to ISLG

Disputes and Dispute Document Library

→ This is where Disputes and the documents related to those disputes will be listed for subscribers to browse through the complete collection.

→ [Listing Page Mockup](#)

- Ability to view listing in a card format that provides more detail for each individual item, with ability to revert to previous view if wanted.
- Ability to view context of how many cases have referred to the decision or award through the card view.
- Can change the view to see disputes only, or disputes with the dispute documents listed below them.
- Ability to sort each of these views.
- Advanced filtering capability.

Treaties and Rules Library

→ This is where all Treaties and Rules in the application will be listed, for subscribers to browse through the complete collection.

- Ability to view listing in a card format that provides more detail for each individual item, with ability to revert to previous view if wanted.
- Ability to view instrument details for each treaty/rule.
- Ability to filter listing by treaty/rule type.

Research Notepad

→ This is where users can collect and manage research documents, pinpoint references and files under an assigned research topic list. From here these files and lists can be printed, downloaded and shared with colleagues.

- Ability to share research notepad topics with colleagues.
- Ability to save excerpt/pinpoint references as well as whole documents to the research notepad.

- Ability to search and filter within research topics.
- Ability to sort documents within research topics, and alter the view.

Document Comparison (New)

→ This is where users can view documents side by side and compare the text, and references in a single view.

- Brand new feature for ISLG. This provides the ability to add documents to a group, and view them side-by side.
- Can compare shared references across research tools within the group.

Document View (New)

→ This is a new way to view documents in ISLG. Users will be able to navigate through the document in different ways, while seeing additional details/analysis about the document.

- Will be able to view document details while browsing through the document.
- Will be able to navigate through the various references made in the different research tools.
- Can navigate through the document using the table of contents.
- Can view all documents related to the same case, or all details of the dispute it is related to.

Article Citator

→ This is where users can see relevant legal instruments that have been referred to in dispute documents.

- Ability to view listing in a card format that provides more detail for each individual item, with ability to revert to previous view if wanted.
- Ability to search through all rules/treaties in the Article Citator.
- Ability to preview excerpt paragraphs.
- Ability to search through the references to specific provisions in a legal instrument.

Jurisprudence Citator

→ This is where users can see a list of decisions and awards (disputes) that have been referenced by subsequent investment treaty arbitral tribunals. See details about the disputes and dispute documents that have referenced the decision or award.

- Ability to search through all the references in this citator.
- Ability to preview excerpt paragraphs.

Terms and Phrases

→ This is where users can see a list of terms & phrases that have been defined in legal instruments and how they have been referred to in dispute documents in the application.

- Easily view jurisprudence related to the term/phrase in a card view for more context.
- Easily view the definition from legal instrument in a card view for more context.
- Linked to the subject navigator to easily relate the term in both tools.
- Ability to preview excerpt paragraphs.

Publication Citator

→ This is where users can see a list of secondary source materials that have been cited by dispute documents. This tool allows subscribers to see relevant details about disputes and dispute documents and the analysis completed by admins.

Subject Navigator

→ This is where users can see dispute and dispute document information organized by subjects, reflecting the Subject Navigator analysis and master tree on the admin side.

Legal Analytics (New)

→ This is where users can get information about available reports, report categories and report types on the Legal Analytics. They can view insights and trends in the data from the analysis performed by the ISLG team through here.

- Can view pre-made reports and manipulate filters to drill down to the information that is important to them.
